ADDICTIONS AND YOUNG PEOPLE

**TO BE HELD ON January 27- 28, 2017
The City Museum, Ljubljana, Gosposka ulica 15, Ljubljana**

The aim of this third regular yearly professional event is to present various forms of addiction in young people and possible approaches to manage these problems, be it in transactional analysis or other therapeutic modalities in Slovenia and abroad. Lectures and workshops have been scheduled to offer direct insight into the methods and practices used by modern therapeutic orientations. The programme also allows participants to join group supervision. A special session is dedicated to presentation of recent publications in the domain.

The Faculty:

- **Stefano Morena**, a psychologist and psychotherapist for children and adolescents, Training transactional analyst and supervisor (TSTA – P), president of I.T.A.C.A (International Transactional Analysts for Childhood and Adolescence, Scientific director of the Master course in psychotherapy of children and adolescents with TA -orientation.
*Lecture: **Web mediated identity and relationality in adolescence: It is not only addiction.***
 - **Maddalena Bergamaschi**, a psychologist and psychotherapist (PTSTA-P, EATA). She is vice president of I.T.A.C.A. (International Transactional Analysts for Childhood and Adolescence), researcher in the I.T.A.C.A. research team and a leader of practical psychotherapeutic work in Brescia.
*Workshop: **Mentalization with the addicted Adolescent. A Transactional Analysis perspective.***
 - **Milan Krek**, MD, a specialist in public health, expert in drug abuse, pioneer in practical preventive activities against HIV infection, founder of the first outpatient office dedicated to management of drug abuse. Assistant Professor at the Chair of Public Health, Medical Faculty Ljubljana. Head of the Drugs Information Point at the Institute of Public Health (associated with EU REITOX system). Widely publishing on the above topics.
*Lecture: **Use of drugs among young people in Slovenia – a public health perspective.***
 - **Ivana Mandarić**, MSc, a social anthropologist, (CTA-P), clinical practitioner in the field of drug abuse, University Dept of Psychiatry, Ljubljana.
*Lecture: **Anthropological perspective of the use of drugs.***
 - **Anja Mihevc**, a social pedagogist, psychotherapist, specializing in TA – P, leader of the consulting centre in DrogArt Association – at the Centre for Counselling and psychotherapy. Active in programmes intended to decrease deleterious consequences of drugs and alcohol, and in activities adjusted to the needs of people using drugs, young ones in particular.
*Lectures: **Working with young people who experiment with drugs and Contact as healing: a different way of working with adolescent users of psychoactive substances.***
 - **Peter Topić**, University diploma in social work, specialist in sexual addiction (CSAT) at the IITAP, founder
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and director of the Institute for addiction and trauma in Ljubljana. Author of the book: *Addiction with sexuality in the digital era* (2015).

- **Sandra Vitas**, a psychologist, MSc in social work in the field of mental health in community, specializing in TA – P. Has been working in education, in health service, in social affairs. In charge of programmes of preventing addiction for young people and families in the Association »UP« (Hope).

- **Dr. Nadezhda Zuykova**, MD, PhD (psychotherapy), certified psychotherapist (PTSTA- P), EAC certified psychologist, narcologist, psychosomatologist, Head of the Department of Psychiatry, Psychotherapy and Psychosomatic Pathology; Professor of the People's Friendship University of Russia (PFUR).

- **Elena Massardi**, a psychologist and psychotherapist, trained in psychoanalytic psychotherapy at PSIBA (School of child and adolescent psychotherapy in Milan, trained at the ITSIEY- Anna Freud Center in London, the Tavisoick Clinic, London, and at the University of Yale, USA).

- **Dr. Andrej Kastelic**, MS, PhD, Associate Professor, Centre for managing addictions with illegal drugs, University Department of Psychiatry, Ljubljana.

- **Dina Kononova**, a psychiatrist, psychotherapist (PTSTA-P). Works in the Private narcological clinic in Moscow, trainer and supervisor in the programme »TA in psychotherapy and counselling« (RAE, Moscow) and in the programme »Transactional analysis«, Practical Psychology and Psychotherapy Department at the People's Friendship University of Russia (PFUR). Scientific field: eating disorders, TA.
*Lecture: **TA psychotherapy and nutrition: boundaries of collaboration in treatment of patients with eating disorders – presentation of a workshop.***
- **Dr. Nada Jabandzic**; psychotherapist (PTSTA-P) and social pedagogist, performs private practise as , lecturer at the Faculty of Cultural Sciences of Klagenfurt, Faculty of Sigmund Freud in Vienna, author of numerous scientific articles in professional journals and at the conferences. She is the editor of the journals BIHOTA, ITAP, a leader of numerous seminars and workshops.
